

2010 Western Winter Workshop's 7th Annual President's Cup Golf Classic

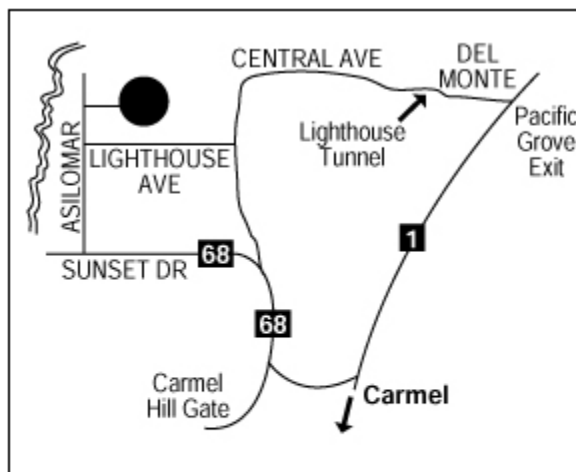
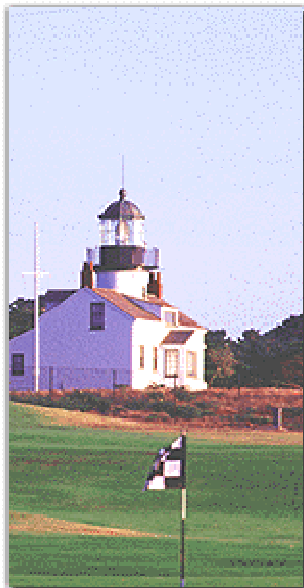
